

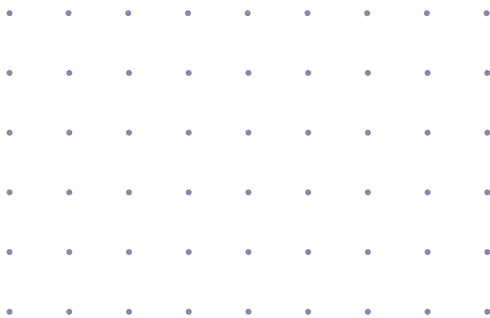

Introduction.

This September marks the eighth anniversary of our first IPR Intelligence Report, initially launched in 2017. Since then, the report has undergone significant evolution, incorporating new sections and refining our analytical techniques—developments made possible through the valuable input of the IP community. The most significant change came last year with the inclusion of all PTAB proceedings, expanding our coverage beyond Inter Partes Reviews to also include Post Grant Reviews (PGR), Covered Business Method (CBM) reviews, and Derivation proceedings (DER).

What began as a groundbreaking addition to our IP Insight series has grown in scope and complexity. As interest in our reports expanded, we broadened our focus to cover seven key areas of intellectual property, including ITC Section 337, Hatch-Waxman Litigation, Patent and Trademark Prosecution, Patent Litigation, the Federal Circuit Court of Appeals (CAFC), and the Patent Trial and Appeal Board.

The PTAB continues to play a key role in the intellectual property landscape, offering a forum for resolving patent disputes that is

faster and often more cost-effective than traditional court litigation. With its various proceedings, PTAB has established itself as a key venue for challenging the validity of patents in the U.S.

Our 2024 PTAB Intelligence Report covers a five-year period from July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2024, offering a deep dive into filing trends, outcomes, and strategies employed by both petitioners and patent holders. It includes insights into patent and claim-level challenges, trends across different types of PTAB proceedings, and an analysis of the most popular International Patent Classification (IPC) codes.

This year's report uncovers notable trends, including a decrease in IPR filings since their 2020 peak, an upward trend in settlement rates, and key performance insights for the top firms and attorneys. Whether you're assessing the competitive landscape or refining your patent strategies, this comprehensive analysis provides valuable perspectives that can inform your decisions and position you for success in the intellectual property arena.

As mentioned above, building on the success of our IPR Intelligence Report, we expanded our coverage last year to include all PTAB proceedings. In addition to IPRs, we cover PGRs, CBMs, and DER proceedings. This broader scope enables us to offer a more comprehensive perspective on the PTAB landscape, delivering valuable insights into the dynamic world of intellectual property. We believe this enhancement provides legal professionals, companies, and stakeholders with a deeper understanding of PTAB proceedings and their influence on the IP ecosystem.

This year's report delivers a comprehensive analysis of five years of PTAB filings, covering the period from July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2024. Readers will gain detailed insights into filing trends, the distribution of different proceeding types, and the roles of patent owners and petitioners. Key metrics at the patent and claim levels, along with the most popular IPC codes and the statuses of terminated proceedings, are examined to provide a thorough understanding of PTAB activity throughout the study period.

Using our [ranking methodology](#), we provide an objective and data-driven assessment of the activity and performance of all parties involved in PTAB proceedings. By analyzing

multiple factors, including the outcomes and the roles of petitioners and patent owners, we calculate scores that reflect each party's involvement and effectiveness. These scores are derived using advanced computational methods, including machine learning algorithms, which allow us to isolate individual contributions and control for external variables. Each party is then ranked based on these scores, enabling us to produce comprehensive rankings that cover petitioners, patent owners, law firms, and attorneys. This methodology ensures that the rankings accurately capture both activity levels and success rates, providing valuable insights into the key players and their impact on PTAB proceedings. Our approach offers a transparent and thorough view of performance across the board, helping stakeholders understand the competitive landscape within the PTAB.

This year's report is delivered as a detailed PDF that presents comprehensive statistics and insights. Alongside the PDF, we provide an Excel file containing all relevant data and metrics, including rankings of law firms, attorneys, companies, lateral moves, and judges. Appendix A: Sources of Data.

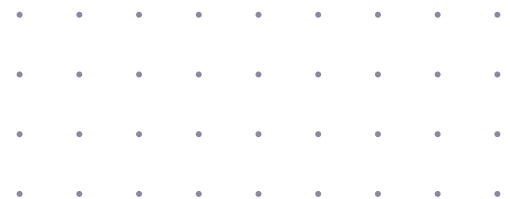
Data forms the bedrock of any data-driven analysis. Therefore, sourcing information from reputable outlets and maintaining data integrity are core principles we rigorously adhere to at Patexia. Our raw data has been carefully collected from a variety of sources, including:

- Patent Trial and Appeal Board (PTAB) Database
- United States Patent and Trademark (USPTO) Patent Database
- Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER)
- Self-reported by attorneys named on the case
- US Patent Classification Database

For this release, we limited the date range of our analysis to the last five years (July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2024).

While errors such as typos are common in legal documents, the task of cleaning and organizing attorney data presents even greater challenges. Attorneys often have similar or identical names, frequently switch firms, fail to update their information, and use various name variations.

To address these issues, our engineering team employs advanced machine learning and natural language processing techniques. These technologies help us accurately match different instances of the same name. To further reduce errors, we implement a two-pronged approach: First, suspicious matches are manually reviewed to ensure accuracy. Second, we offer profile pages for over 100,000 attorneys and agents, allowing them to directly review and contribute missing cases to our database. All user-contributed data is then carefully validated by Patexia's internal data team to ensure the highest level of precision.

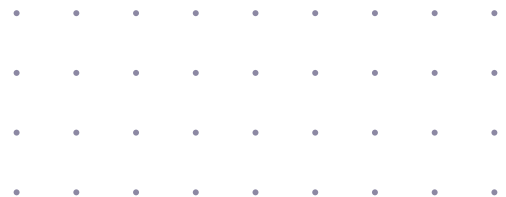

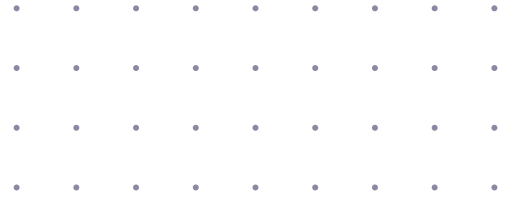
Appendix G: Best Performing and Most Active Badges.

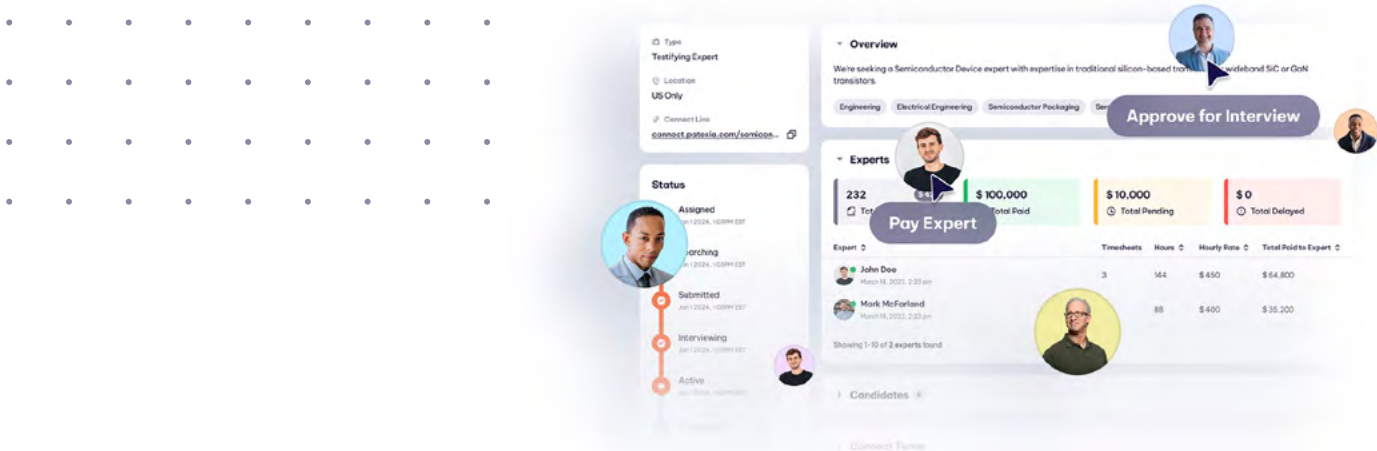

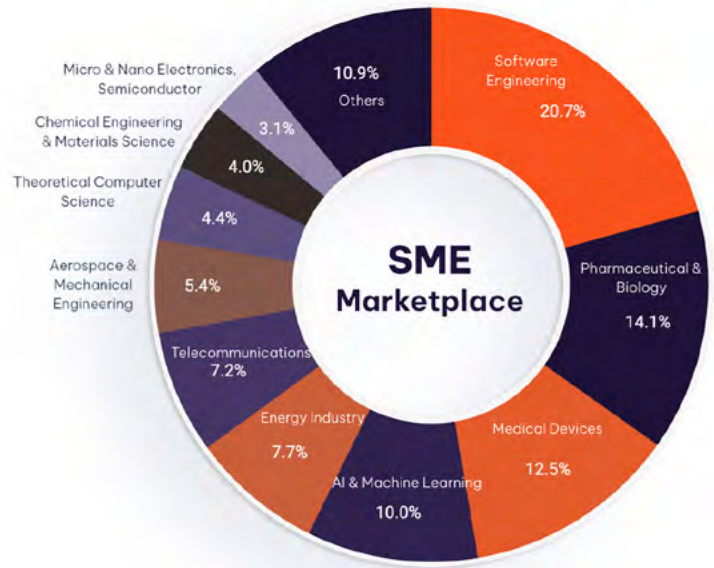
